1.0 Policy

Residents Defined

Only pupils whose parents are residents of the City of Detroit, or pupils who are legal residents of the district, or as otherwise provided by law, will be considered residents and entitled to the privileges of the Detroit public schools. All other pupils will be classified as nonresidents.

Nonresidents Who May Attend Detroit Schools

Nonresident pupils may be officially admitted to the Detroit public schools upon approval of the general superintendent, payment of tuition, and as otherwise provided by law. No nonresident pupil will be admitted to the exclusion of any legal resident.

Nonresidents Who Must Pay

1. All nonresident pupils will be required to pay tuition and other fees in accordance with the legal provisions therefore.
2. Credit will be allowed towards tuition for any current school taxes paid by parents or guardians in the City of Detroit, as provided by law.
3. Failure to pay tuition, in whole or in part, may constitute cause for the pupil's removal from the Detroit public schools. This part will be implemented by the general superintendent or a designee.

General Superintendent Will Determine Fees and Refunds

1. Resident and nonresident fees for courses in adult education, apprentice training, and other courses will be established by the general superintendent.

2. Refund of tuitions and fees paid may be made in accordance with a refund schedule established by the general superintendent.
