1.0 Policy

Board approval of the recommendations made by one of its committees or the General Superintendent will constitute approval of the action recommended without the full report being read in open meeting provided that copies of the report have been made available to Board members and the public prior to the meeting. Therefore, the committee chairman or the General Superintendent may read only excerpts from the report.

In such cases, committee reports will be preceded by a statement by the person reading the report as follows:

“Because the Board members have received complete copies of the report of the _____ Committee prior to this meeting and complete copies have been made available to the public, I am going to read only excerpts of the report at this time.”
