1.0 Policy

1.1 DEVELOPMENT OF SECURITY PROTOCOLS

The administration at each facility will be responsible for developing and publishing appropriate security protocols for their particular facility. The DPS in cooperation with the police, courts, public agencies, community groups, and the media will work together to strengthen the Public Safety protocols at each facility in the District.

1.2 ASSISTANCE OF DPS SECURITY DEPARTMENT

Additionally, Public Safety will provide trained staff and services to assist schools in guarding against trespassing, theft, vandalism, assault, fire and accidents, and all types of activities that may disrupt the education process. Public Safety personnel so assigned will work closely with the principal, reporting incidents daily in accordance with security department regulations.

1.3 USE OF FIREARMS

The Detroit Police Department sworn officers and Public Safety may carry arms within a DPS building. Security personnel may not bear firearms or any other weapon in the schools.
