1.0 Policy

Actions taken by the Board of Education will seek to fulfill in practice:

1. That all children of the city will be provided with equal educational opportunities throughout the school system, regardless of race, creed, color, country of national origin, or sex.
2. That all children will have equal opportunity to participate in any program offered as part of the curriculum of the Detroit public schools regardless of race, creed, color, country of national origin, or sex.

Further, the Board will make its programs, services, and facilities available to all qualified persons regardless of handicap.
