1.0 Policy

1.1 RESPONSIBILITY FOR FILING ANNUAL REPORT

The General Superintendent, with the approval of the school board, shall submit an annual report to the mayor, governor, school district accountability board, and legislature. This annual report shall also be made available to the school community.

1.2 <u>CONTENTS OF ANNUAL REPORT</u>

The annual report shall contain, at a minimum, the following information:

- a. a summary of the initiatives that have been implemented to improve school quality in the district;
- b. measurements that may be useful in determining improvements in school quality in the qualifying school district. These measurements shall indicate changes from baseline data from the school year before the appointment of the Detroit Board of Education, and shall include at least all of the following:
 - i. standardized test scores of pupils
 - ii. dropout rates
 - iii. daily attendance figures
 - iv. enrollment figures
 - v. high school completion and other pertinent completion rates
 - vi. changes made in course offerings
 - vii. proportion of school district resources devoted to direct educational services
- c. A description of long-term performance goals that may include statewide averages or comparable measures of long-term improvement.

1.3 APPROVAL OF ANNUAL REPORT

The General Superintendent must submit the annual report to the Board for review and approval prior to submission of the report to the mayor, governor, school district accountability board, state legislature, and Detroit community.
