1.0 Policy

The safety of students in school, on their way to and from school, and at all school-sponsored activities is of deep concern to the Board. The entire staff shares responsibility for maintaining a safe school environment. The cooperation of parents, the community, and other public agencies is necessary.

The staff will direct particular attention to:

1. Maintaining safe physical conditions in buildings and on school grounds.
2. Observing and enforcing safe practices, particularly in those areas of instruction and student activities which offer special hazards.
3. Offering safety education to students as pertinent to particular subjects and activities.
4. Enforcing the Uniform Code of Student Conduct.
5. Ensuring that there are no intruders in the building.

School administrators will be responsible for implementing safety rules and regulations in their schools and for reporting unsafe conditions.
