1.0 Policy

The Board will provide summer schools within its available resources. In doing so, it will give priority to the basic curriculum and remedial programs.

Except as summer programs are funded by outside sources, the Board may charge tuition and fees in order to make the summer schools self-sufficient. Such fees will be established on the basis of the cost of the program and will be set on a per subject basis for residents and for nonresidents.

Any student whose home high school does not offer in summer school a required course in which he or she needs credit will be permitted to enroll in such a course if available in another high school, provided the students meets the established requirements.

Courses to enable students to develop proficiency in basic subjects as required for graduation will ordinarily be offered at all summer schools. When possible, the Board will fund these courses.
